There are two main types of questions in English: questions that can be answered with a simple yes or no, and questions that require a more detailed response. Are you happy today? Yes, I am. Did you have fun at the party. No, I didn't. Will you come to class tomorrow? Yes, I will. Information questions are asked with the question words what, where, when, how, why, and which. These questions require longer answers to provide the specific information requested. Notice that each of these questions are answered with the positive or negative form of the helping verb.
